

The second sale of the 2017 summer season took place in Port Elizabeth today, with 141 012 kg's on offer.

The offering consisted of good quality mohair with some excellent individual clips. Despite pressure from a consistently stronger currency, the market held up well, with the average market indicator closing marginally down by 1% on R184.73.

All buying houses participated actively on the sale, with both kids and young goats remaining stable, although comparison with the previous sale was not possible due to no summer market indicator on the first sale.

The strong adult market closed 1% higher, even under difficult trading conditions and taking into account the stronger rand.

A highest price of R330.00 per kg was paid for a bale of super style 26 micron kid hair.

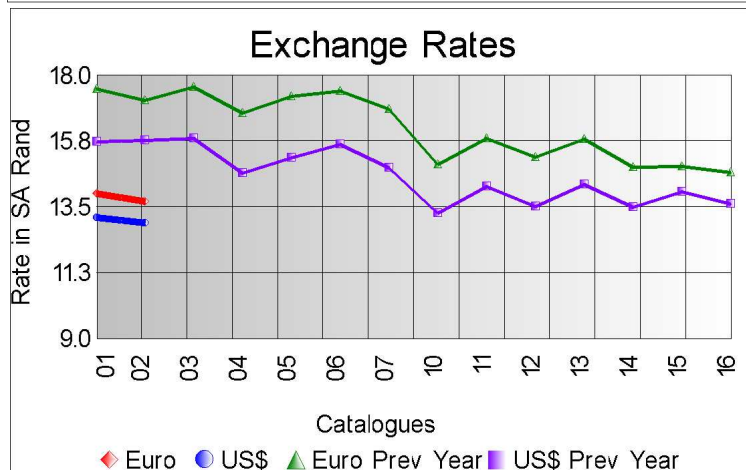
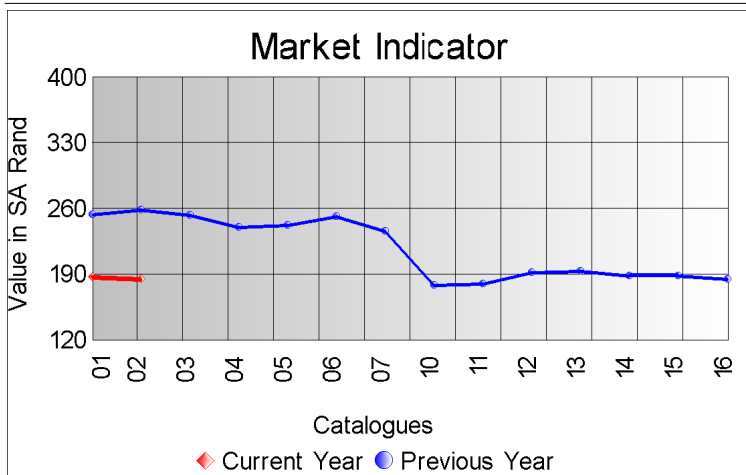
