

The fifth sale of the 2021 summer season took place in Port Elizabeth today, 11 May 2021, with 173 058 kg on offer of which 95% was sold.

The offering consisted of good quality mohair, with slightly stronger microns and lower yields than the previous sale.

Despite the fact that the SA currency traded stronger, the market remained fairly stable as the buying houses competed actively for the mohair on offer, especially to obtain RMS-certified mohair. The average market indicator decreased by 4% (unchanged in dollar-terms) compared to the previous sale to close on R389.09 p/kg.

A highest price of R900.00 p/kg was paid for a bale of superstyle 23 micron kid mohair.

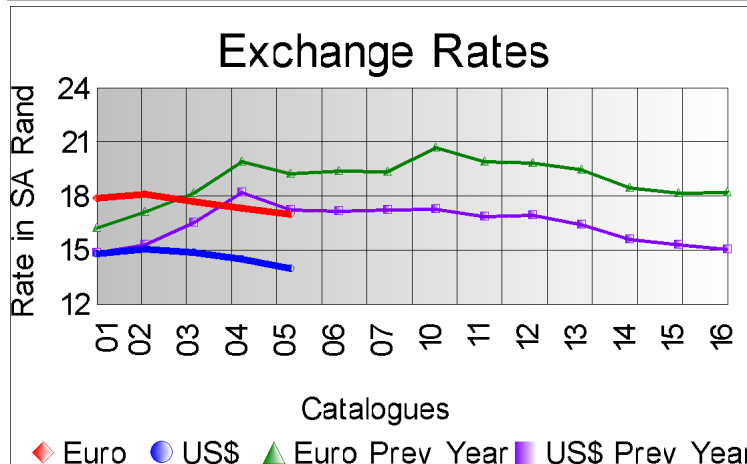
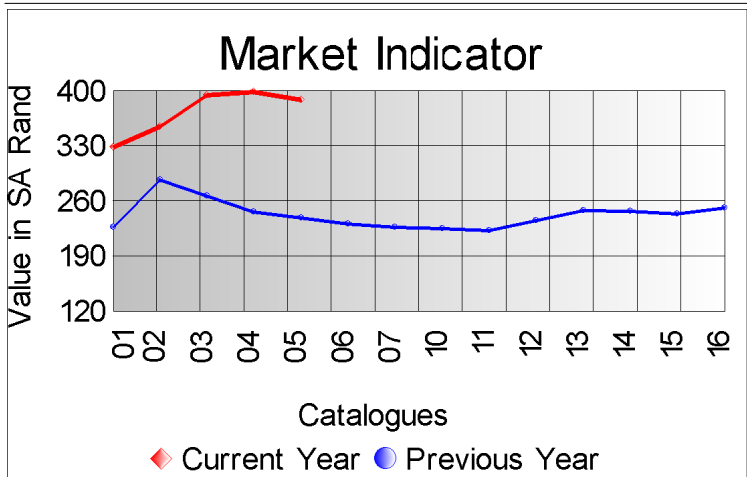
