

The third sale of the 2022 summer season took place in Port Elizabeth over two days, 22 and 24 March 2022, with 163 151.2 kg on offer of which 98% was sold.

The offering is the biggest quantity of the year so far and consisted of some good quality mohair. The buying houses competed actively for all types of mohair on offer with RMS-certified mohair attracting the most competition.

The average market indicator increased by 2% (7% in dollar terms) from the previous sale to close on R442,24 p/kg despite the SA currency trading stronger.

A highest price of R848 p/kg was paid for a bale 24 micron good style kid mohair.

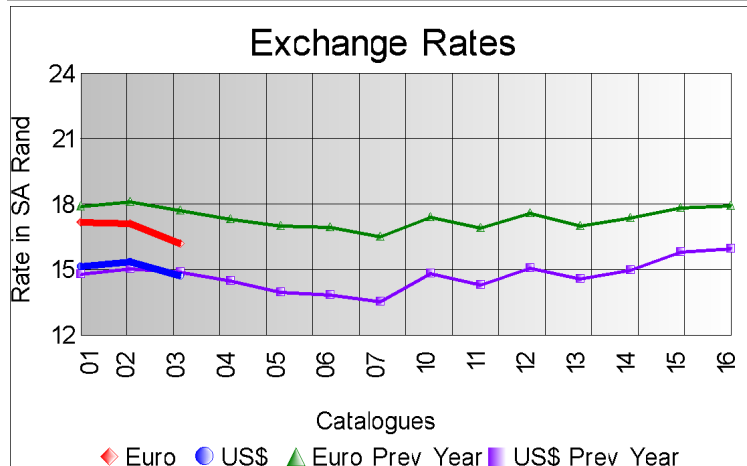
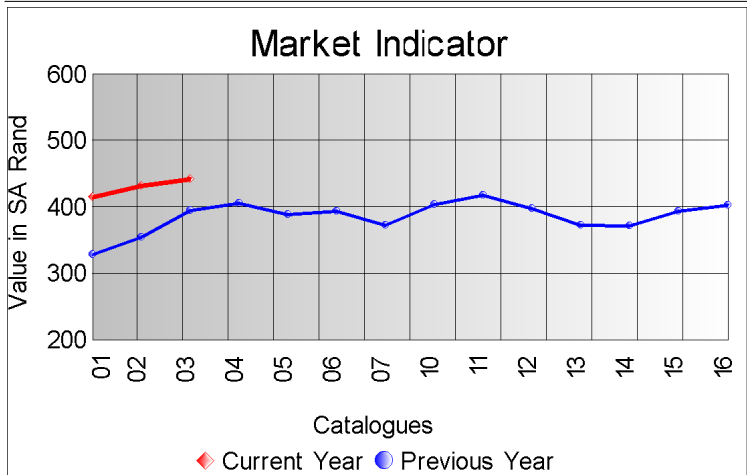
