

The fourth sale of the 2022 winter season took place in Port Elizabeth today, with 169 543 kg's on offer of which 56% was sold.

The offering was made up of good quality mohair, with 73% of the mohair being RMS certified. This sale continued on the same trend as the previous sale with the buying houses being relatively passive. China has still not returned into the market as they slowly build their economy after COVID-19. Europe continues to struggle with extravagant energy costs resulting in high inflation and interest rates, all effecting our international mohair buyers' ability to purchase mohair.

A highest price of R700 p/kg was paid for a bale of 25 micron kid mohair.

More than 40% of the mohair at today's sale remains unsold, as buyer offers fell short of growers' reserves. As a consequence, comparing the results to the previous sale is difficult, and the results may be skewed.

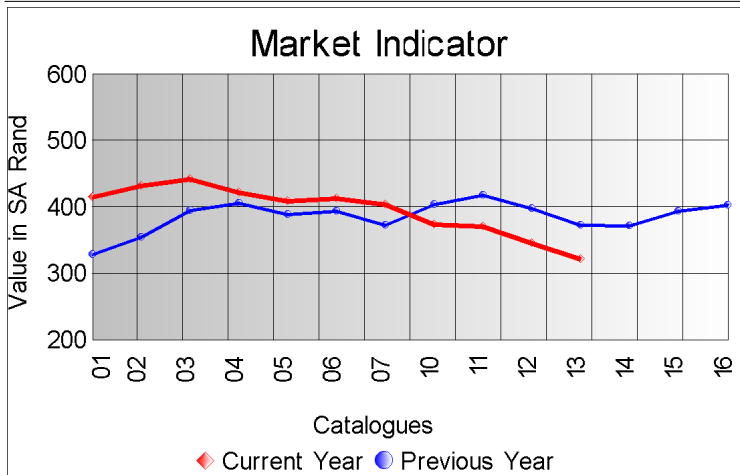

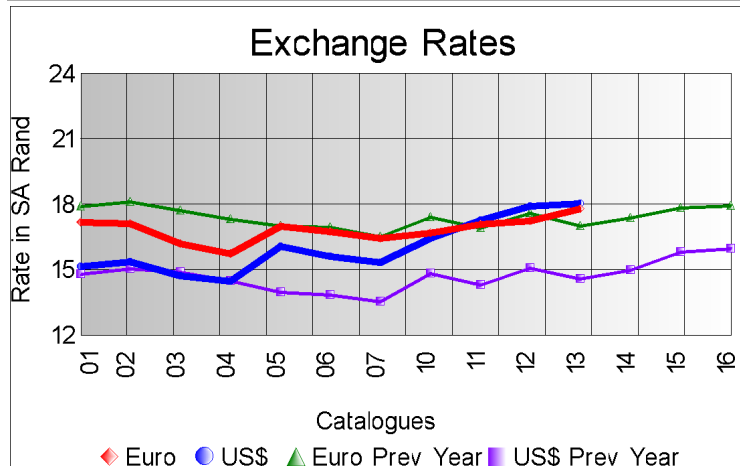
