

The fourth sale of the 2024 summer season took place in Port Elizabeth on 16 April 2024, with 176 290 kg on offer of which 96% was sold.

The offering consisted of good quality mohair, with 92% of the mohair on offer being RMS-certified.

Although not all buying houses were active during the day, the competition amongst the buying houses that participated were good which indicates positive current demand for mohair. The South African currency traded similar to the dollar compared that of the previous mohair sale.

The average market indicator decreased by 1% (1% in dollar terms) from the previous sale to close on R401.17 p/kg.

A highest price of R860 p/kg was paid for a bale 23.5-micron super style kid mohair.

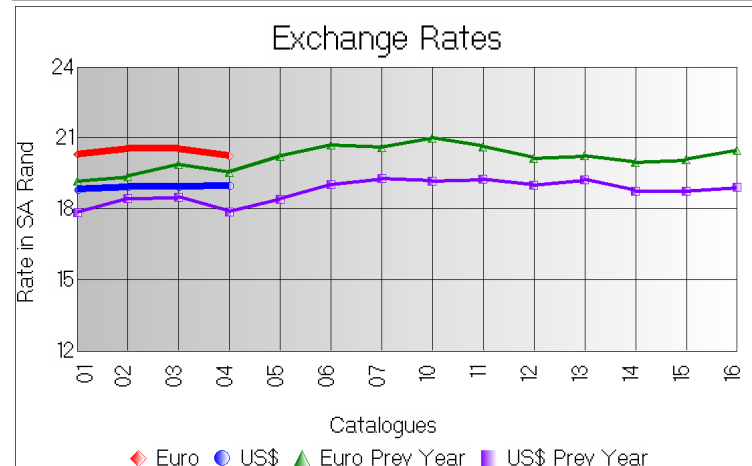
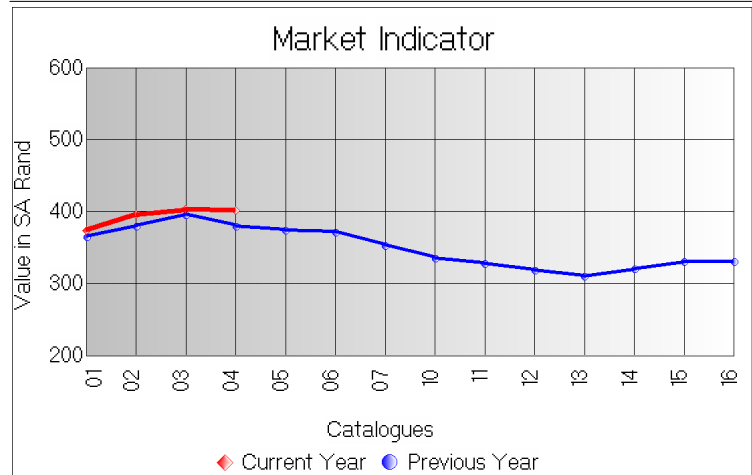
