

The fifth sale of the 2024 summer season took place in Port Elizabeth on 30 April 2024, with 164 096 kg on offer of which 85% was sold.

The offering consisted of good quality mohair, with 80% of the mohair on offer being RMS-certified.

The South African currency traded 1.5% stronger to the dollar compared that of the previous mohair sale. Once again, not all buying houses were active during the day, with the top makers purchasing the majority of the mohair on offer today. The demand for mohair reduced during the two weeks from the previous sale, negatively impacting the competition on the auction floor.

The average market indicator decreased by 5% (4% in dollar terms) from the previous sale to close on R381.11 p/kg. A highest price of R900 p/kg was paid for a bale 23 micron super style kid mohair.

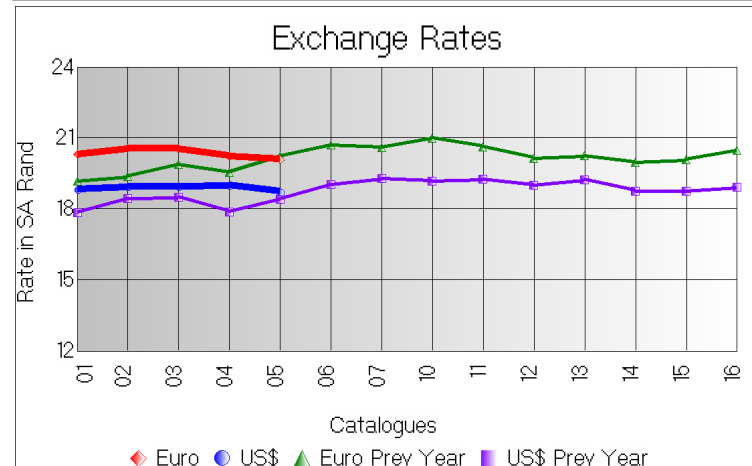
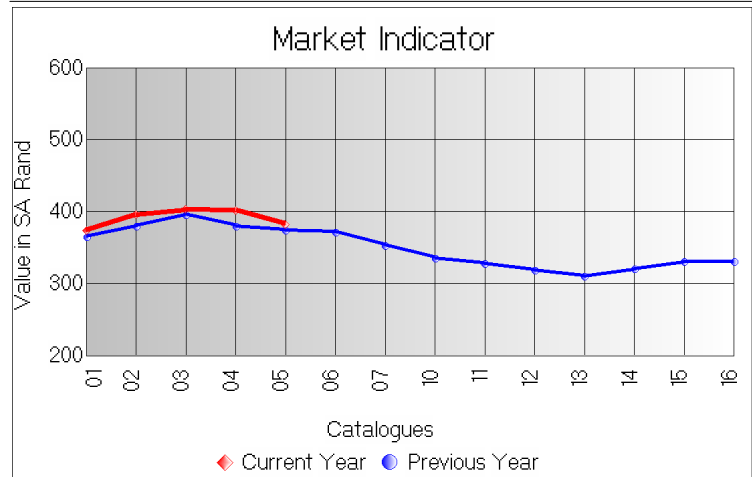
